- Create/rename pages if necessary
- Close all pages
- Edit base.dwt to complete navbar & links
- Update all; publish all to dunx1
- In browser, test links on navbar

## Breadcrumb trail

- See examples:
  - <http://d1.dir.dcn.yahoo.com/Arts/Humanities/Events/>
  - <http://www.pages.drexel.edu/~corseel/dw/dwmore.html>
- Use on pages more than 1 level deep
- Final item on trail (current page) should NOT be linked
- Use and/or adapt “.breadcrumb” class

## Internal anchors

- Allows user to “jump” to section of page
- Create anchor (spot to which to jump)
  - Select text
  - From Insert menu, choose “Named Anchor”
  - Give the anchor a simple, lower-case name (e.g., “top”)

## Link to anchors

- Create TOC at top of page; apply `.breadcrumb` class
- Select one subject
- Link box: `#anchorname`

---

## Link to top

- Create “up to top ^” text throughout page
- Create `.uptotop` class
  - Right align text
  - `.7ems`
- Highlight “up to top ^”
- Insert menu / Layout Objects / div tag “wrap around”; class `.uptotop`
- In link box: `#top`

## Updating styles

- Navbar
  - `#nav`
  - `#nav a:link`, etc.
- Colors & links in left-hand column
  - `div#column p`
- Colors, links, top border in footer div
  - `#footer`

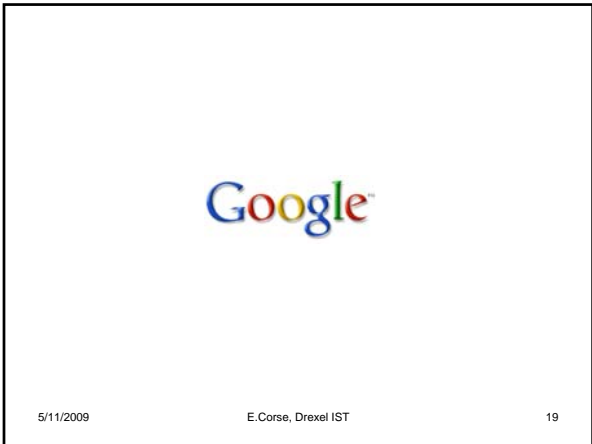

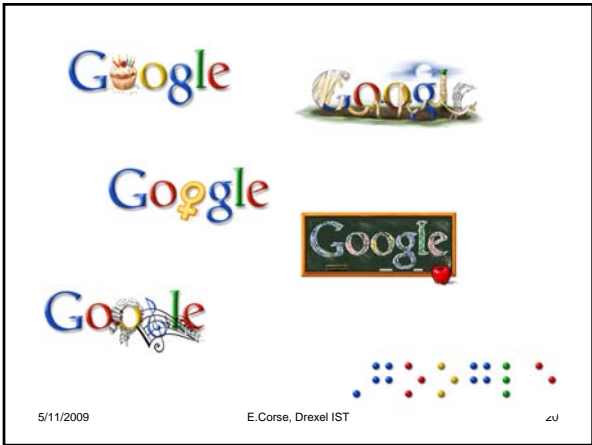

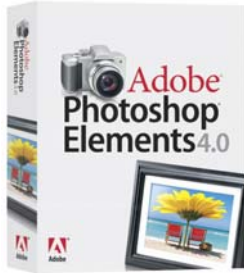
