Want to “see” your brain at work?

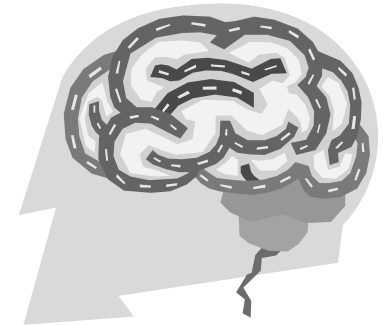
Drexel University is conducting research to study how the brain works during everyday activities (e.g., reading).

- Must not be on psychoactive medications
- Must not smoke 1 or more packs of cigarettes per day
- Must not drink more than 5 caffeinated beverages per day
